

Cottonwood Heights Thanksgiving Day 5k

Thursday, November 23, 2017

- Race will begin at 9:00 am on the south side of the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center (7500 S. 2700 E., Cottonwood Heights, UT 84121).
- We challenge you to run faster than the Mayor, Kelvyn Cullimore, who will be wearing a red shirt and the #1 bib. Those who finish faster than him will receive a special edition medal for their victory!
 - Note that the medal is not a participation award; you must beat the Mayor to the finish line to receive one.
- Plan on arriving EARLY for the race. Carpooling or being dropped off is recommended, and see our parking map for where to and where not to park.
- We would appreciate you leaving your dogs at home, but if they join you, please make sure they are on a leash and please line up in the back.
- Strollers are welcome but also must line up at the back, behind the other runners at the starting line.
- If you are a slow runner or plan on walking, please also plan to start near the back of the line.
- Although most intersections are controlled by police or volunteers, please be aware of cars, as this course is still open to traffic.
- If you have or see a problem on the race course, please contact a Cottonwood Heights Police Officer or other race officials.
- The finish line will be east of 2700 East on Banbury Road and is very clearly marked.
- After finishing, please be cautious when heading back to the Recreation Center, where there will be plenty of refreshments.
- Awards and recognition will be given to the overall male and female adult winners, overall male and female 11 & under winners. This part of the event will start at 9:50am in the gymnasium.
- Ribbons will be available for pickup in the ice arena lobby shortly after top finisher awards, for 1st-5th place in each age division for males and females.
- The Raffle will follow right after our awards ceremony, and you must opt in and be present to win.
